AROUND THE WORLD:

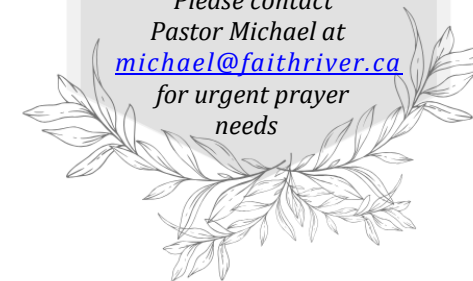
Portugal: GIVAS & CHRISTINA FEHR APARECIDA with Operation Mobilization- There is a prayer letter on the bulletin board in the foyer.
