Faith River! We have an opportunity to volunteer with Meals on Wheels, and show the love of Jesus. This is the invitation we received this week:

We are reaching out on behalf of Saskatchewan Health Authority (SHA) Volunteer Services regarding our Meals on Wheels program in Saskatoon. Meals on Wheels is a community-based service that provides nutritious meals to seniors, individuals with disabilities, and other vulnerable members of our community who rely on this support for their daily well-being.

At present, we are experiencing a growing demand for this service, with an increasing waitlist of individuals hoping to be included in the program. Due to a shortage of volunteers, it has become increasingly difficult to expand delivery routes and maintain consistent service. On some occasions, we are even required to cancel routes when volunteer coverage is not available.

In response to this need, we are reaching out to local churches and community organizations in the hope of building partnerships that can help strengthen and sustain this important service. Meals on Wheels volunteers play a meaningful role not only in delivering nutritious meals, but also in providing brief social interaction and informal wellness checks for clients who may otherwise feel isolated. Even a small weekly commitment—such as approximately two hours—can make a significant difference in someone's day and overall quality of life.

The volunteer commitment is flexible, and full training and orientation are provided. No prior experience is required, only a willingness to serve and compassion for those in need.
